Ryan R Jeroski Appointment as Municipal Manager

On Wednesday evening, September 13, 2023 the Council of the Township of Hampton unanimously appointed Ryan R. Jeroski as the Township's new Municipal Manager effective February 2, 2024. Mr. Jeroski's employment with the Township will begin on November 6, 2023 where he will shadow current Municipal Manager Christopher Lochner until his retirement on February 1, 2024. Ryan R Jeroski is a native of Oakmont and graduate of Westminster College and the University of Pittsburgh's Graduate School of Public and International Affairs. Ryan began his career in public service working for GVF, a nonprofit Transportation Management Association in King of Prussia, Pennsylvania. After working with PennDOT, transit agencies, municipalities, and major employers to address traffic and transportation issues in the Philadelphia region, Ryan came back to his hometown to work as Assistant Manager/Secretary for the Borough of Oakmont. In June 2016, Ryan was hired by Peters Township as Assistant Township Manager. In this role, he served as chief financial officer, and performed various other functions including project management, grant writing, policy development, and oversight of the hiring process. Ryan was also the Township's staff liaison to the Environmental Quality Board. Among a slew of capital projects completed during his time at Peters, Ryan was lucky enough to be a part of the team at Peters that oversaw the design and construction of the 98-acre Rolling Hills Park. Outside of work he spends most of his time biking, hiking, and volunteering with the Western Pennsylvania Conservancy.
